THEME

Theme: God's Peace is Always Near
This week helps children discover that Jesus offers
a peace the world cannot give. God's peace
comforts, steadies, and rests gently in our hearts.
Through nature, art, and Scripture, children learn
that God's peace is always near.



SCRIPTURE



"Peace I leave you; my peace I give you." John 14:27

Read the verse slowly. Invite your child to place a hand on their heart.
Say together:

"Jesus gives me peace."

PRAYER

Jesus, thank You for Your beautiful gift of peace. Help me breathe deep, feel calm, and always remember that You are near. Guide me with Your gentle love and continue to fill me with Your grace. Amen



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

- " Peace I leave you; my peace I give to you." John 14:27
- 1) What does peace feel like to you?
- 2) What helps your heart feel calm?
- 3) Where do you need Jesus' peace today?

NATURE

Step outside and invite your child to notice signs of peace:

- Bees collecting nectar and pollen
- Birds singing
- Feeling the sun and wind on their face
- · Listening to the sound of flowing water

Talk about how God's peace feels like these quiet moments, gentle, steady, purposeful, and comforting.

End with a simple breath prayer: Inhale: Jesus, fill me with peace. Exhale: Your love is with me.



CRAFT



KINDNESS

Create "Peace Jar" Art

Materials:

Small jar

Water

Glitter or sequins

Food Coloring

Glue to seal the lid

Steps:

- 1) Fill the jar with water
- 2)Add glitter/sequins and one drop of food coloring
- 3)Use glue to seal the lid
- 4) Shake the jar and watch the glitter/sequins swirl, then settle.

Say together: Let the peace of Jesus settle in my heart.

Choose to be a peacemaker this week:

- 1. Speak softly when someone feels upset
- 2. Help calm a worried friend
- 3. Use respectful language
- 4. Ask for forgiveness
- 5. Be responsible for your actions
