THEME

Theme: Love one another

This week teaches children that love is not only something we feel but also something we do. Jesus shows us how to love with kindness, generosity, and a heart that welcomes everyone.



SCRIPTURE



"Love one another as I have loved you." John 15:12

Say the verse together. Invite your child to put a hand over their heart.

Say together:

"I will love like Jesus."

PRAYER

Jesus, thank You for loving us more than we can ever imagine. Help us to love others with gentle hearts, kind words, and open hands. Guide our steps this week so that we may share Your love with everyone we meet. Amen.



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

"Love one another as I have loved you." John 15:12

- 1) What do acts of love look like?
- 2) How did Jesus show His love?
- 3) How can you love like Jesus this week?

NATURE

Step outside and invite your child to notice signs of love and life:

- sunshine warming the earth
- trees providing shelter or shade
- parent playing with their child
- heart shaped leaves or stones
- animals feeding their babies

Talk about how God's love makes life grow. Ask: "Where do you see love today?"

End with a simple breath prayer: Inhale: Jesus loves me. Exhale: I will love others.

- Choose to love like Jesus this week:
 - I. Include someone who feels alone2. Forgive someone who upset you
 - 3. Listen and help someone you know

Create a Love Chain

Materials:

- paper (cut into strips)
- markers
- tape or glue

Steps:

- 1) Write one loving action on each strip of paper. (share, forgive, help, include, give thanks, listen)
- 2) Loop and tape/glue the strips into a paper chain.
- 3) Hang the love chain. Remind your child that each link is a way to love.

Say together:

"Each link is a gift of love."
