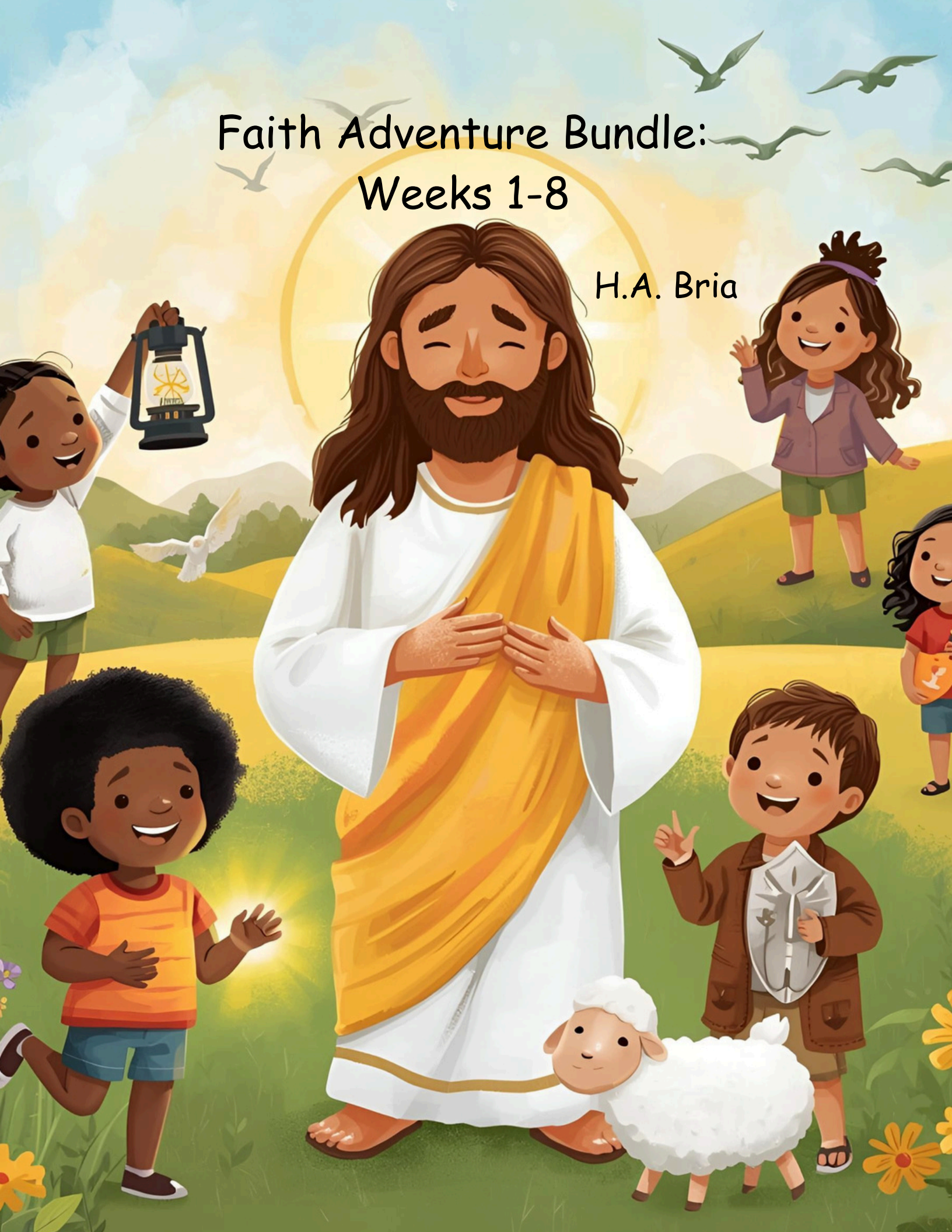

Faith Adventure: God Knows My Name

THEME

Theme: God Knows My Name

This week, we explore the beautiful truth that God knows each child personally, every smile, every tear, all hopes, and every fear. Through Scripture, creativity, nature activity, and performing kindness, families are invited to rest in God's gentle and attentive love.



SCRIPTURE

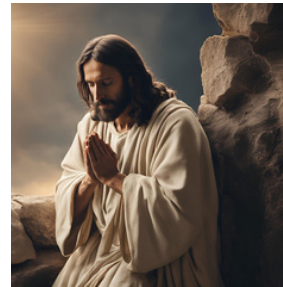


"I have called you by name, you are mine." Isaiah 43:1

Say the verse softly together. Repeat the child's name after reading it.

PRAYER

Jesus, thank you for knowing and loving me. Help me trust that You walk with me, call me by name, and hold my heart with gentle care. Guide my steps this week, so that my life truly reflects your love.



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

"I have called you by name, you are mine." Isaiah 43:1

- 1) How do you think God feels when He looks at you?
- 2) What do you think it means to belong to God?
- 3) How does it make you feel knowing that God knows your name?

NATURE

- Something tiny
- Something growing
- Something colorful
- Something hidden but still there

Talk about how God notices even the smallest things in us too.

End with a simple breath prayer:

Inhale: God knows me.

Exhale: God loves me.



CRAFT

Create “God Knows My Name” Art

Materials:

Drawing Paper

Markers, Pencil Crayons or crayons

Stickers (optional)

A photo of your child (optional)

Steps:

- 1) Write your child's name in the center of the page (or have them write it)
- 2) Decorate the name with colors, drawings, or patterns
- 3) Around the name, add words and illustrations that describe God's love: "Chosen," "Beloved," "Seen," "Known," "Cherished."



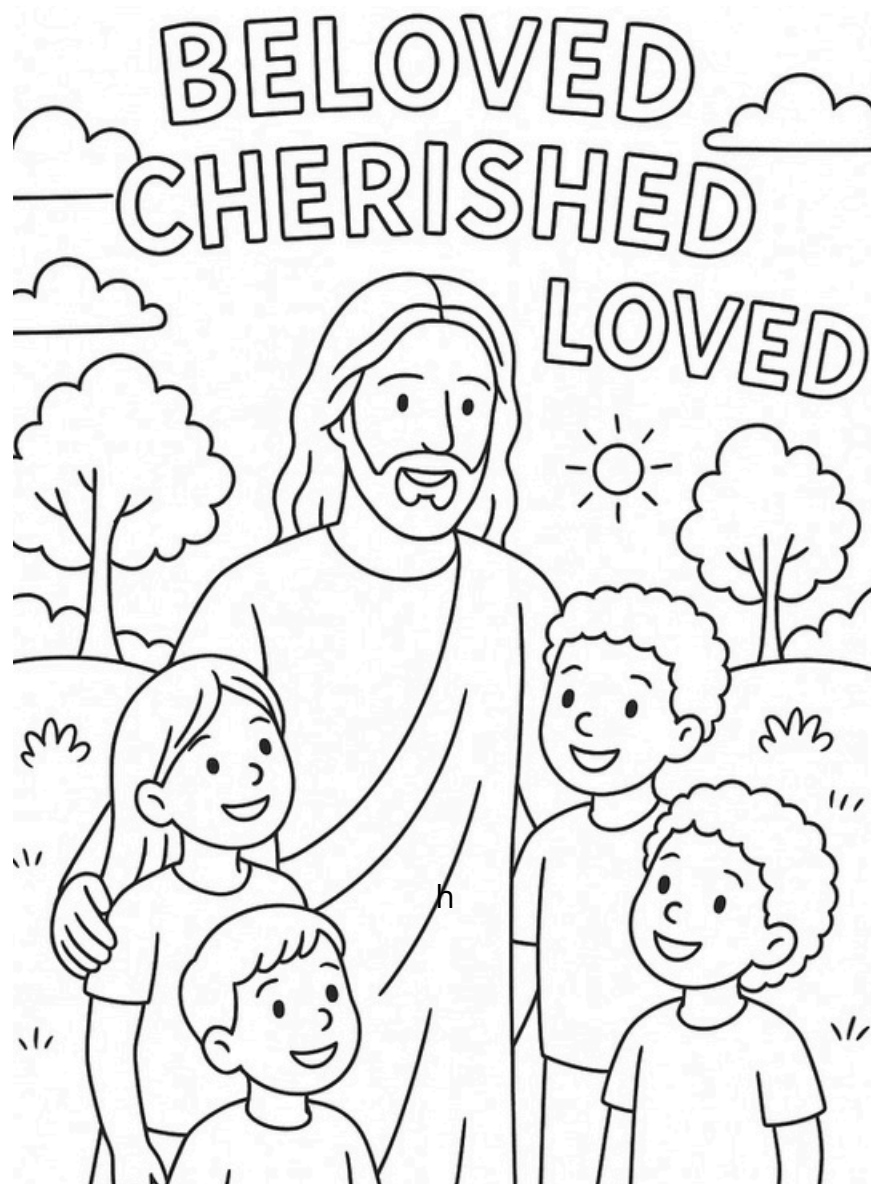
KINDNESS

Here are a couple of ways to shine Jesus' light this week:

- Write someone's name on a card and include a kind message. Notice how the person feels after reading your message.

Faith Adventure: The Good Shepherd

THEME

Theme: Jesus Guides Me

This week helps children discover that Jesus is always watching over them, gently guiding, protecting, and calling them toward peace. Through nature activities, prayer, reflection, and creativity, children are reminded that they can trust Jesus in every moment of their lives.



SCRIPTURE



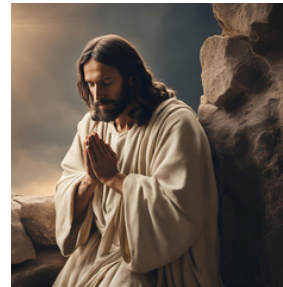
"I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me." John 10:14

Read the verse slowly together. Invite children to imagine Jesus calling their name like a shepherd calling a lamb.

Say together: "Jesus, I belong to You."

PRAYER

Jesus, our Good Shepherd, thank you for watching over us with gentleness and love. Lead us when we are unsure, comfort us when we are afraid, and guide us along Your path of peace. Amen.



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

"Read John 10:11-15.

- 1) What do you think a shepherd does?
- 2) How does Jesus take care of us?
- 3) When do you feel close to Jesus?
- 4) When do you feel you need Jesus to help guide you?

Say together: "Jesus, I trust You."

NATURE

Step outside and invite your child to listen for:

- Birds
- Wind
- Leaves rustling
- Footsteps

Talk about how we listen for Jesus in our hearts not always with our ears.

End with a simple breath prayer:

Inhale: Lead me, Jesus.

Exhale: I follow you.



CRAFT

Create “Cotton-Ball Sheep” Art

Materials:

- Paper
- Cotton Balls
- Glue
- Markers
- Googly eyes (optional)



Steps:

- 1) Draw a simple outline of a sheep
- 2) Add glue and gently press cotton balls onto the body (not the face)
- 3) Draw the features of the sheep's face
- 4) Add details such as the sky, ground, birds, flowers...
- 5) Save a space to write “Jesus is my Good Shepherd.”

KINDNESS

Choose ways to shepherd someone with kindness:

- Help a younger child
- Comfort a friend
- Show someone the way
- Invite someone who is alone to play
- Help someone in need (family, friend, neighbor, teacher)

Faith Adventure: God Provides

THEME

Theme: God Cares For Us

This week helps children discover that God's love is attentive and faithful. Through scripture, nature activity, prayer, and simple practices, families learn to trust that God provides for our needs with gentle care.



SCRIPTURE



"Our Father knows what we need." Matthew 6:32

Read it softly and slowly.

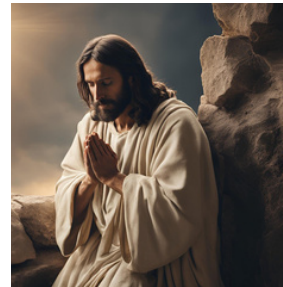
Invite your child to take a deep breath and rest in these words.

Say together:

"God cares for us."

PRAYER

God, thank You for watching over me with gentle care. You know what I need even before I ask. Help my heart trust You in moments of plenty and in moments of worry. Guide my steps this week so that I may walk in Your loving way. Amen.



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Read Matthew 6:25-26

- 1) What do birds need each day?
- 2) Who takes care of them?
- 3) What do you need each day?
- 4) How does God take care of your heart and your body?

NATURE

Step outside and look for signs of God's provision in the natural world:

- rain moistening the soil
- trees offering shelter/shade
- plants that provide food
- birds gathering food/nesting material

Talk about how each living thing receives what it needs.

End with a simple breath prayer:

Inhale: God sees me.

Exhale: God provides.



CRAFT



Create a simple bird feeder.

Materials:

- Pinecone
- Peanut butter, honey, or sunflower butter
- Birdseed
- String

Steps:

- 1) Spread peanut butter, honey, or sunflower butter onto the pinecone.
- 2) Roll it in birdseed until covered.
- 3) Tie a string at the top and hang it outside.
- 4) Watch the birds come and enjoy.

Say together:

“God provides for all creation.”

KINDNESS

Here are some ways that you can provide for someone this week.

- donate clothing to someone in need
- help prepare a meal help an elderly neighbor with chores write a note to
- encourage a friend or family member



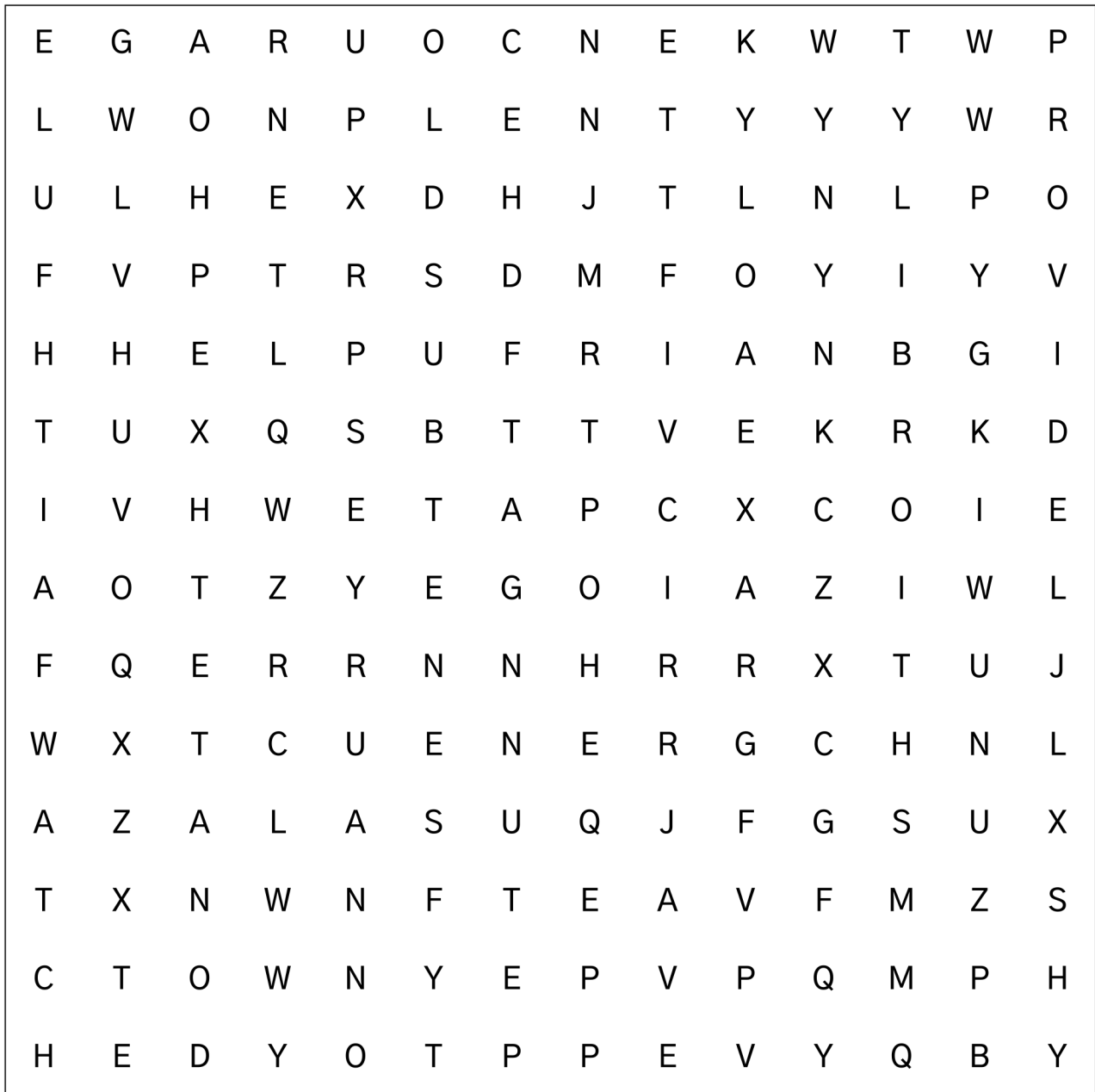
