REFLECTION

- Which of Jesus' blessings sound the most surprising?
- How can being kind or gentle help others feel loved?

NATURE ACTIVITY

Finding Hidden Blessings


Go outside together and look for things that are small but beautiful: patterned stones, patterns in bark, sunlight on leaves, a bird chirping, cloud formations made of tiny water droplets, spiderwebs, velvety moss on trees.

Talk together:

Jesus teaches us that blessings are not always loud or flashy. Sometimes they are quiet gifts we notice when we slow down.



CRAFT



Craft: Tree Bark Rubbing

Jesus teaches that God's blessings are not all the same. Just as every tree has its own pattern, God creates each person with unique beauty and purpose.

Materials:

- Paper
- Colored pencils/crayons
- Trees with textured bark

Steps:


- 1) Place a piece of paper against the tree bark.
- 2) Hold the paper still with one hand.
- 3) Gently rub the side of a pencil or crayon over the paper.
- 4) Watch the tree's pattern appear on the page.
- 5) Try rubbing different trees to see how each pattern is unique.
